I make obeisance to the eternal preceptor in the form of Lord Sankara, who is all wisdom and resting on whose brow the crescent moon, though crooked in shape, is universally adored.

यत्सत्त्वादमृषैव भाति सकलं रज्जौ यथाहेर्भ्रमः।
यत्पादप्लवमेकमेव हि भवाम्भोधेस्तितीर्षावतां
वन्देऽहं तमशेषकारणपरं रामाख्यमीशं हरिम्॥

I adore Lord Hari, known by the name of Sri Rama, who is superior to and lies beyond all causes, whose Maya (illusive power) holds sway over the entire universe including gods from Brahma (the Creator) downwards and demons, whose presence lends positive reality to the world of appearances- even as the dales notion of a serpent is entertained with reference to a rope- and whose feet are the only bark for those who are eager to cross the ocean of mundane existence.

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
